

“Smash the Easter Egg” Fundraiser

Raising money for your youth mission trip or next event? Try this fun, Easter-themed fundraiser idea.

What You’ll Need:

- A few dozen eggs
- Easter-themed prizes
- Volunteers



Before the event, acquire a few dozen eggs—ask for donations! Hard boil one egg out of every dozen. You’ll also need some simple, cheap Easter-themed prizes, one for each dozen. Here’s the most important part of your fundraiser preparation: you will need to recruit several volunteers who are good sports. The youth pastor, head pastor, and other church leaders would be perfect for this. See if other local leaders or well-known community members (sports coaches, school principal, mayor) would be willing to participate as well.

How It Works:

The volunteers sit on chairs. People pay \$1 or \$2 to crack an egg on a volunteer’s head. If the egg is uncooked, they don’t win a prize—but really, smashing the egg on the head is a win! If they pick the hard-boiled egg, they win one of the Easter-themed prizes.



The more volunteer “victims” you have, the better! This will hopefully attract more people to take part in your Easter fundraiser; some may be willing to pay for more than one chance at cracking an egg. If you charge \$2 per egg, you would raise about \$20 for every dozen eggs, depending on how much you spend on the prizes.
